Entry Fees: Becker Brothers Challenge \$35.00. This class will include the judge's educational commentary for the audience and rider. One winner will be recognized. **RIDERS MAY ONLY WIN THIS CLASS ONE TIME IN THEIR ACADEMY CAREER.** Limited to the first 10 entries received.

Leadline \$15.00 per class Qualifying Classes \$20.00 per class Championships \$25.00 per class

Office Fee \$15.00 per horse/rider combination

Checks should be made payable to St. Louis National Charity Horse Show. Checks returned for NSF will result in an assessment of a \$50.00 fee. A 4% Credit Card Processing Fee will be added if paying with either Visa/MasterCard

Services: A farrier will be on the grounds Mid Rivers Equine Hospital will be on call EMT will be on grounds

Rules and Regulations: The Academy Class is a MHSA Sanctioned event and will be run according to MHSA Rules.

However the St. Louis National Charity Horse Show has been granted an exemption to the rules set forth by MHSA in regards to splits.

Splits will be handled: All Walk/Trot/Canter classes will be split at the 12th rider

Walk/Trot Classes for riders 8 & Under will split at the 6th rider

All other Walk/Trot classes will split at the 9th rider

Please bring enough horses to accommodate your needs. Splits will not be granted to accommodate a shortage of horses.

Any class with less than three entries may be combined with the next older age group in that division.

If MHSA rules do not cover a particular issue, USEF rules will govern. In the event that this issue is not covered by either set of rules, show management, in its own discretion will exercise judgment and exhibitors will agree to abide by that decision.

The judge's decision is final

Any horse that the judge deems to be out of control will be excused from the show ring immediately.

Run downs/polo wraps/therapeutic bandages are permitted on any academy horse competing in the show.

Current Coggins exams are required on all horses on the show grounds. Entries will not be accepted without proof of a negative Coggins.

All riders who compete and are judged in the preliminary classes are eligible for their respective Championship classes.

Protective headgear (ASTM-SEI) is **STRONGLY** encouraged for all riders and drivers and is **REQUIRED** for all junior riders and drivers.

Awards – in all classes, ribbons will be awarded through sixth place. Championship trophies & other awards will be presented in championship classes.

If mailing or faxing Academy entries – they must be received by Friday September 23, 2016 – after that date please bring your entries to the show.

Sponsorship make the Academy Classic possible. Please ask your parents and youth groups to consider making a contribution to this event. Class sponsorship is \$25.00; Championship Sponsorship is \$100.00.
