### GENERAL INFORMATION, RULES & REGULATIONS

"EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH."

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

**ENTRIES** - Please use one entry blank per horse. Exhibitors are requested to file their entries as soon as possible before entries close. Entries will close on Sept. 6, 2021.

Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split any class if entries warrant or USEF rules require it. Management also reserves the right to change the order of classes or to move classes to another ring. Management reserves the right to decline any entry for any reason and to return money owed before or during the show without being liable for compensation.

#### POST ENTRIES AND LATE FEES

Post entries will be accepted as follows: Management may accept post entries should they be needed to fill a class and show can provide stabling. In such cases there may be an extra charge of \$30 per horse entered. Additional entries for horses already entered in the show will be accepted upon approval by management NO LATER THAN THE DAY BEFORE THE CLASS BEING REQUESTED. PAYMENT IN FULL MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES.

REFUNDS If an entry is to be canceled, the horse show office must receive official notice no later than SEPTEMBER 12, 2021. The Show will issue a refund, less the \$50 office fee. After this date, the exhibitor shall forfeit his entry fee. In either case, **NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE ON STALL FEES.**

CHECK OUT Any mistakes at check out must be resolved within 24 hours. No refunds will be given. Please check your bills carefully.

STALLS Due to limited space, all horses must show out of a stall. Permanent 10 x 10 stalls of wood construction & dirt floors with doors will be available. Stall fees must be paid by the closing date,

BEDDING: All bedding must be purchased through the horse show office before 12:00 Noon. Exhibitors using outside shavings will be charged \$25 per stall.

#### IMPORTANT- PLEASE NOTE STALL AVAILABILITY

Stalls will be available at 8:00 a.m. Tuesday, September 13, 2021

Monday arrivals, other than those already on site from the prior week's show, will be assessed a \$25 directly by the National Equestrian Center. This will be payable to the facility, not the horse show. Stalls must be vacated by 6midnith, Sunday, Sept. 19. 1For your convenience LATE NIGHT ARRIVALS are possible.

ADDS & SCRATCHES Adds and Scratches may only be made in the Horse Show Office on the Official Form, by letter or by facsimile and must be received prior to the start of the first class entered in. Any other method WILL NOT be considered valid. Once a class begins, it may not be scratched, except for a Vet Scratch. If a Vet Scratch, the horse must be scratched on the same day of the class/classes and scratched in the Horse Show Office on the Official Form and the Official Vet's Certificate must be received in the Show Office by close of business that day.No same day adds.

**Reminder:** All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement, to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. **MEASUREMENTS** An exhibitor needing a horse or pony measured must make an appointment with the show Steward. Horse and pony measurements will be on Friday at 1:00 p.m.

**WE LOVE DOGS, BUT** All dogs must be kept tied or on a leash. Loose dogs may be impounded and their owners charged a \$100 fine.

**FOOTING** Rings and warm-up areas are a combination of sand and clay.

Main Ring - 120' X 245' Ring II - 140' X 225'

Jumper Ring (Outdoor) - 240' x 350' - footing all weather

**JUMP ORDERS** A rotating jumping order may be established and posted for all classes over fences. If posted, all horses must be ridden in the posted order. Rider or trainers who have conflicts due to multiple entries in a class must see the in gate so that necessary adjustments can be made.

**PRIZE MONEY** Prize Money breakdown: 30%-22%-15%-13%-10%-10%. Prize Money will be credited to each exhibitor's account. Any credit due will be mailed within 30 days following the show. No prize money will be mailed unless owner's (or other designated payee's) social security number and complete address are listed on the entry blank.

#### **RIBBONS**

Hunter and Equitation classes - Trophy and ribbons 1st -8th,

Jumper classes - Trophy and Ribbons 1st - 8th, unless noted otherwise.

**RESPONSIBILITY** Under the Equine Liability Act, each participant who engages in an equine activity expressly assumes the risks on engaging in and legal responsibility for injury, loss or damage to the person or property resulting from the risk of equine activities.

**WHILE EVERY EFFORT HAS BEEN MADE TO AVOID MISTAKES IN THIS PUBLICATION, THE HORSE SHOW MANAGEMENT, PARTNERS, AND STAFF ASSUME NO LIABILITY FOR ERRORS. SIGNIFICANT ERRORS OR CHANGES WILL BE DISCLOSED TO EXHIBITORS WHOSE ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED, UPON THEIR ACCEPTANCE; AND OTHERWISE IN ACCORDANCE WITH USEF RULES.**

The St. Louis National Charity Horse Show follows the guidelines of the State of MO and the United States Equestrian Federation to protect the health and safety of all the horses at the show. At the printing of the prize list, the following are the requirements for all horses entering the property.

1. All horses must have proof of negative coggins test performed within 12 months of the show.
2. All out of state horses must have a Health Certificate within 30 days of the show.
3. VEE vaccination within 14 days of entry on horses originating from states in which VEE has been diagnosed within the preceding 12 months. An entry permit is also required on horses from such states.
4. USEF GR 845

All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months prior to entering the property. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management.

Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of the vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.

2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations, name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.
3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.
4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.

Copies of all necessary health papers will be requested at the horseshow office at check in.

## 2021 REGION 5 "CENTRAL" ASPCA NHSAA MACLAY REGIONAL FINALS Class #600

Entries for Regional MacLay Championship classes close, and must be received by, 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time, September 1, at the NHSAA office, except if that date should fall on a Sunday, in which case they must be received no later than 5 p.m. on the following Monday. Entries must be on the Official Entry Form, signed, and submitted with the \$150.00 per class Entry Fee made payable to the NHSAA. The NHSAA reserves the right to reject any late or unsigned entries or entries not submitted with all entry fees.



### Schooling Area Protocol for Regionals and Finals USHJA Equitation Task Force

- ~ Official schooling area will be set one hour before the start of the competition.
- ~ Schooling fences will be set as a straight line of oxers across the middle of the official schooling area.
- ~ Each jump will have at least four standards, four rails and four cups.
  - ~ Each jump must be flagged.
  - ~ Each jump may be set as an oxer.
  - ~ Each jump may be set as a vertical.
- ~ Each jump may be set as a combination (Bounce, One Stride or Two Strides)
- ~ Tarps (vinyl panels) and coolers are to be allowed. These may be used on the jump, under the jump or on the ground in front of or behind the jump. If they are used on the ground in front of or behind the jump they must be set on the ground a minimum of 9 feet and a maximum of 21 feet from the jump in either direction. They may not be set in such a way that they interfere with either the approach or landing of another jump.
  - ~ Straight lines may not be set.
  - ~ Bending lines may not be set.
- ~ All other USEF Schooling Rules for the Equitation section will be enforced.

#### USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE RULE

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

#### USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

"Every Class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current United States Equestrian rule book, will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith."

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

#### FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulteur or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

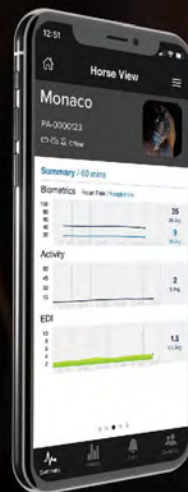
