ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY FEES AND UNLESS PROPERLY AND COMPLETELY FILLED OUT STALL REQUESTS NOT HELD WITHOUT MONEY. STALL RESERVATIONS WILL BE ASSIGNED AS ENTRIES ARE RECEIVED. PLEASE RETURN YOUR STABLING LIST EARLY TO ENSURE YOUR STALLS ARE TOGETHER.

#### POST ENTRIES AND LATE FEES

Post entries will be accepted as follows: Management may accept post entries should they be needed to fill a class and show can provide stabling. In such cases there may be an extra charge of \$30 per horse entered. Additional entries for horses already entered in the show will be accepted upon approval by management NO LATER THAN THE DAY BEFORE THE CLASS BEING REQUESTED. PAYMENT IN FULL MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES.

REFUNDS If an entry is to be canceled, the horse show office must receive official notice no later than SEPTEMBER 11, 2023. The Show will issue a refund, less the \$50 office fee. After this date, the exhibitor shall forfeit his entry fee. In either case, NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE ON STALL FEES.

CHECKOUT Any mistakes at check out must be resolved within 24 hours. No refunds will be given. Please check your bills carefully.

STALLS Due to limited space, all horses must show out of a stall. Permanent 10 x 10 stalls of wood construction & dirt floors with doors will be available. Stall fees must be paid by the closing date,

BEDDING: All bedding must be purchased through the horse show office before 12:00 Noon. Exhibitors using outside shavings will be charged \$25 per stall.

#### IMPORTANT- PLEASE NOTE STALL AVAILABILITY

Stalls will be available at 3:30 p.m. Monday, Sept. 11, 2023, unless you are staying over from the DMB Show. Early arrivals will be assessed \$25 directly by the National Equestrian Center. This will be payable to the facility, not the horse show. Stalls must be vacated by midnight, Sunday, Sept. 17. For your convenience LATE NIGHT ARRIVALS are possible.

ADDS & SCRATCHES Adds and Scratches may only be made in the Horse Show Office on the Official Form, by letter or by facsimile and must be received prior to the start of the first class entered in. Any other method WILL NOT be considered valid. Once a class begins, it may not be scratched, except for a Vet Scratch. If a Vet Scratch, the horse must be scratched on the same day of the class/classes and scratched in the Horse Show Office on the Official Form and the Official Vet's Certificate must be received in the Show Office by close of business that day. No same day adds.

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement, to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. ## General Information, Rules & Regulations

**“EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.”**

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and acad-emy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

**ENTRIES** - Exhibitors are requested to file their entries as soon as possible before entries close. Entries will close on Sept. 6, 2023. Please enter through [horseshowsonline.com](http://horseshowsonline.com)

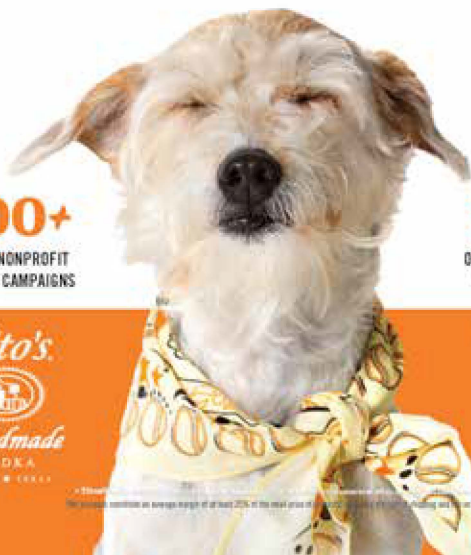

Management reserves the right to decline any entry for any reason and to return money owed before or during the show without being liable for compensation.

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# WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba USEF Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and St. Louis National Charity Horse Show ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

**A. RULES AND REGULATIONS:** I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org), as amended from time to time.

**B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK:** I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

### EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.

**Under the laws of most States, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.**

**C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

**D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY:** In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("Liability") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

**E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE:** This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

**I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS DOCUMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY, UNDERSTAND ALL OF ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS, AND KNOW IT CONTAINS AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND WAIVER FROM LIABILITY, AS WELL AS A HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS.**

By signing below, I (as the participant or as the Parent/Legal Guardian of the minor identified below) hereby accept and agree to the terms and conditions of this Agreement in connection with my (or the minor's) participation in any USEF Event. If, despite this Agreement, I, or anyone on my behalf or the minor's behalf, makes a claim for Liability against any of the Released Parties, I will indemnify, defend and hold harmless each of the Released Parties from any such Liabilities as the result of such claim.

The parties agree that this agreement may be electronically signed. The parties agree that the electronic signatures appearing on this agreement are the same as handwritten signatures for the purposes of validity, enforceability, and admissibility.

NIGHT WATCH FEE: All horses occupying a stall, showing and non-showing, will be required to pay a show night watch fee of \$10 per show. Horses will be checked each night of the show week every 2 hours. This service is NOT optional. **HJ107i. Night Watch:** Security and monitoring service offered to exhibitors, which must be available to contract at an additional cost, for horses stabled on the grounds

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**MEASUREMENTS** An exhibitor needing a horse or pony measured must make an appointment with the show Steward. Horse and pony measurements will be on Friday at 1:00 p.m.

**WE LOVE DOGS, BUT** All dogs must be kept tied or on a leash. Loose dogs may be impounded and their owners charged a \$100 fine.

**FOOTING** Rings and warm-up areas are a combination of sand and clay. Main Ring - 120' X 245' Ring II - 140' X 225'. Jumper Ring (Outdoor) - 240' x 350' - footing all weather

**JUMP ORDERS** A rotating jumping order may be established and posted for all classes over fences. If posted, all horses must be ridden in the posted order. Rider or trainers who have conflicts due to multiple entries in a class must see the in gate so that necessary adjustments can be made.

**PRIZE MONEY** Prize Money breakdown: 30%-22%-15%-13%-10%-10%. Prize Money will be credited to each exhibitor's account. Any credit due will be mailed within 30 days following the show. No prize money will be mailed unless owner's (or other designated payee's) social security number and complete address are listed on the entry blank.

**RIBBONS** Hunter and Equitation classes - Trophy and ribbons 1st -8th, Jumper classes - Trophy and Ribbons 1st - 8th, unless noted otherwise.

**RESPONSIBILITY** Under the Equine Liability Act, each participant who engages in an equine activity expressly assumes the risks of engaging in and legal responsibility for injury, loss or damage to the person or property resulting from the risk of equine activities.

**WHILE EVERY EFFORT HAS BEEN MADE TO AVOID MISTAKES IN THIS PUBLICATION, THE HORSE SHOW MANAGEMENT, PARTNERS, AND STAFF ASSUME NO LIABILITY FOR ERRORS. SIGNIFICANT ERRORS OR CHANGES WILL BE DISCLOSED TO EXHIBITORS WHOSE ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED, UPON THEIR ACCEPTANCE; AND OTHERWISE IN ACCORDANCE WITH USEF RULES.**

The St. Louis National Charity Horse Show follows the guidelines of the State of MO and the United States Equestrian Federation to protect the health and safety of all the horses at the show. At the printing of the prize list, the following are the requirements for all horses entering the property.

1. All horses must have proof of negative coggins test performed within 12 months of the show.
2. All out of state horses must have a Health Certificate within 30 days of the show.
3. VEE vaccination within 14 days of entry on horses originating from states in which VEE has been diagnosed within the preceding 12 months. An entry permit is also required on horses from such states.
4. USEF GR 845

All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months prior to entering the property. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of the vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.

2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations, name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.
3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.
4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon requests by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.

Copies of all necessary health papers will be requested at the horseshow office at check in.

These Area Championship classes will be run using the same format as our own Maclay Regional Finals. Open to any riders that have earned points in these classes during the current competition year, these classes are designed to give our members an opportunity to gain experience and to compete on a larger scale against other riders from their same geographical area. The Champion, Reserve Champion and Thirdplace finisher from each Area Championship, if not otherwise qualified, will receive invitations to compete in the Hamel Foundation NHS 3'3" Equitation Finals or the THIS Adult Equitation Finals. Riders that are qualified for both the Hamel Foundation National Horse Show 3'3" Equitation Championship and the Maclay Regionals (and/or the Maclay Finals) may enter and compete in both the Hamel Foundation NHS 3'3" Area Championship and the ASPCA Maclay Regionals.

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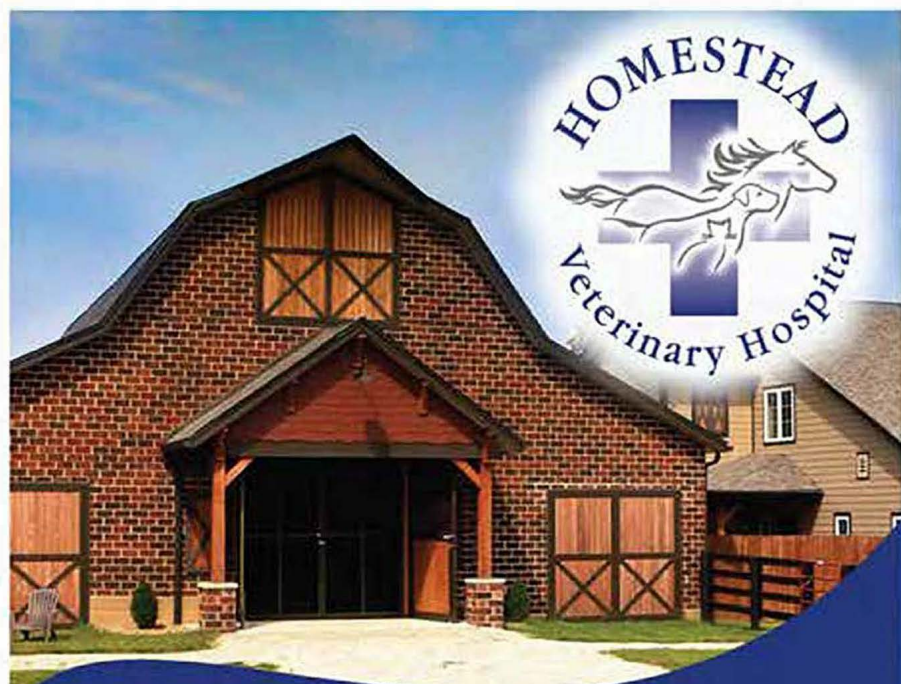

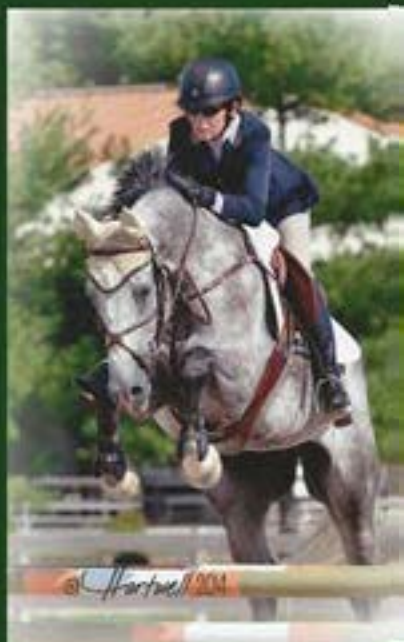

## USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE RULE

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

## USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to limit entries in any class, section or division; to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries; to disqualify any riders or exhibitors; to prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants. Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the show management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause. Each horse entered will be assessed a \$23.00 Federation fee, which is forwarded to USEF.

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. 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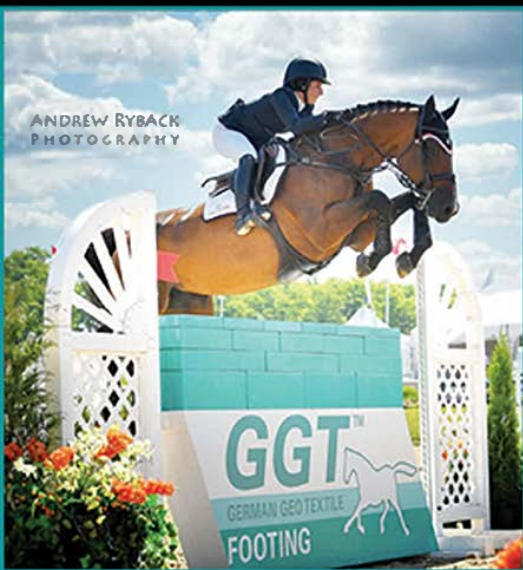
